Healthy Living

Cooking Matters- This is a 6 week course with a focus on parents of children 0-8 to teach healthy eating habits on a budget. While teaching kitchen skills.

Oral Health- Screening and dental sealant program in all Washington County school districts. Cavity Free at 3 program.

Fit Station- Here we have certified child safety passenger safety technicians, who can install up to date car seats. At Connections we are able to help parents size their child to the correct car seat.

Healthy Snacks- In Akron and Otis schools we provide healthy snacks and recipes for all ages. Easy on the go health snacks.



Our building is available for meetings and trainings for a small donation.

Resources

WCC provides public advocacy, capacity building, and resource development to strengthen our community network.

Area Resource and Referral- Information on and referral to local, state, national programs and services.

Food Bank- Emergency food assistance including perishable and nonperishable food and personal care items. As well as Christmas Dinner baskets.

Mobile Pantry- A once a month food distribution program.

Emergency Service Program- Limited assistance with rent, utilities, emergency shelter and food. Also information and referrals.

Nurturing Father's- Evidence bases classes for developing attitude and skills for male nurturance.

Incredible Year's- Parenting program that focuses on ages 3-6 years old.

CDOT- Educating young people about car seat and seat belt safety.

Action Team- This is an opportunity for local service providers to collaborate together and sharing their programs and resources. We usually meet 2nd Thursday of each month.

Early Childhood Education

B.L.A.S.T.-Babysitter Lessons and Safety Training. This two day course teaches basic babysitting skills for ages 11-15.

Early Childhood Support Services- Information and training for child care providers and preschool teachers. As well as being members of Washington County ChildCare Assosiation.

Family Literacy- Activities for children and families. We have books and totes in English and Spanish.

Lending Library- Books, totes and resources on many topics. Toy and equipment library for child care providers and foster parents.

Literacy Activities- Reading activities and book giveaways to all in home providers and school districts in Washington County, on a monthly basis.
