

APPROVAL OF HANDBOOKS AND DIRECTIVES

In order that pertinent Board policies, district regulations, and/or school rules and procedures may be known by all staff members and students affected by them, the Superintendent is granted the authority to issue staff and student handbooks as found necessary and desirable.

It is essential that the contents of all handbooks conform with district-wide policies and regulations. It is also important that all handbooks bearing the name of the district be of a quality that reflects credit on the district. Therefore, the Board expects all handbooks to be approved prior to publication by the Board and/or Superintendent.

The Board shall review and approve district handbooks so that the contents may be accorded the status of Board-approved policy and regulation.
