PERFORMANCE RESPONSIBILITIES:

1. Subscribes to an oath of allegiance as required by law.
2. Seeks professional growth and contributes to the life of the community.
3. Devotes his time exclusively to school duties during school hours.
4. Responsible for the classification grading and promotion of students in accordance with the instructions of the Superintendent and Board policy.
5. Serves on committees upon request which may be formed for the purpose of improving some phase of the school program.
6. Provides a school life for student which will prepare them to deal effectively with their social and economic needs.
7. Cooperates with the Superintendent and other teachers to provide the best possible education for each individual student to the end that the student may be a good citizen of the community, state, nation and world.
8. Sponsors extra-curricular activities when requested by the Superintendent.
9. Is informed about the purpose of educational organizations and the activities which they attempt to carry on in the interest of the profession and public education.
10. Participates in school affairs and accepts responsibility for understanding the problems of financing public education.
11. Performs such other duties as may be assigned by the Superintendent of schools.

TERMS OF EMPLOYMENT: Nine Month year. Salary and work year established by the Superintendent of schools in accordance with policies of the Board of Education.

EVALUATION: Performance of this job to be evaluated by the Superintendent of schools in accordance with policies of the Board of Education.
