EXEMPTIONS FROM REQUIRED INSTRUCTION

If the religious belief and teachings of a student or his parent or legal guardian are contrary to the content of a school subject, or to any part of a school activity, the student may be exempt from participation. To receive such an exemption the parent or legal guardian must present a written request for exemption to the school Superintendent stating the conflict involved.

If a student is unable to participate in a physical education class, he must present to the school Superintendent a statement from a physician stating the reason for his inability to participate.

Exemptions from required instruction do not excuse a student from the total semester hours required for graduation.
